To properly and thoroughly reconstruct a forklift engine, a good business would totally disassemble it. A heat cleaning system can then be used to clean all the parts. When this step has been finished, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any defects, any breakage or any extensive wear. Certain components such as crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are reground, resurfaced and resized if considered necessary. Several parts like gears, nuts, bolts etc. are repaired or replaced as considered necessary.

The engine is rebuilt by hand when the overhaul has been finished. After putting it back together, a series of tests are applied to the working equipment. This is done in order to check all of the parts to guarantee there are no issues or leaks. If any problems occur, the needed adjustments are made.
